Welcoming Oritsé, COSW Chair Sylvia Daisy Romanus said: 'Oritsé's experience as a young carer makes him ideally suited to this advocacy role. We look forward to working with him to draw attention to the needs of young carers and the key role of social workers.'

Oritsé said: 'I committed myself to highlighting the situation of young carers when I was a teenager and young carer for my mother. I am now proud to have the opportunity to work with COSW and the Commonwealth as an advocate for young carers and to meeting many young carers during our tour over the coming months.'

Oritsé knows the reality of the life of a young carer because he took on the role himself as a teenager after his mother developed Multiple Sclerosis. He committed himself to championing the cause of young carers long before rising to musical stardom with JLS.

Oritsé has already attended the launch of the Commonwealth Year of Youth at the Commonwealth Headquarters on 30th January when he spoke out about young carers.

To the delight of fans, JLS has announced that they are reuniting and about to embark on a [UK-wide concert tour](#) of major venues reaching thousands of fans. Oritsé will talk about his experience as a young carer during the tour and promote the need for a Commonwealth Young Carer Charter.

COSW will be announcing further joint activities with Oritsé in the months ahead leading to CHOGM 2024, including a Commonwealth young carer webinar in June in partnership with the Commonwealth Secretariat.
